### Get Nectar-rich Quick Wildflower Mix

Quick growing annual, biennial & perennial Scottish wildflowers for a range of sites providing a nectar source for pollinating insects including bees, moths & hoverflies. After the annual species have finished, the perennials & biennials will continue to develop over the years. There are 36 species in this mix.
